Motor Vehicle Regulations

The following regulations apply to all motorized vehicles, including mopeds, scooters, and motorcycles, used by students during school hours or on school activities. Infractions of these rules may necessitate the student's from being deprived of his/her driving privilege for school purposes.

1. Students may not transport nonfamily member students unless the Clearance to Transport Students section has been completed and submitted.
2. Students driving automobiles, mopeds, scooters, and motorcycles to school are required to register them at the Registrar's Office and to obtain a parking permit. The parking permit must be visible in the car whenever it is parked at MVA.
3. Vehicles are to be parked only in the student's assigned parking spot. The school does not assume responsibility for damage or loss.
4. Vehicles are not to be used during school hours except by written permission from the parents and school administration.
5. Students should not be in the parking lot unless they are entering or leaving the campus. No loitering and loud music are allowed while parked on campus.
6. For insurance purposes, a student is not to borrow another student's car, moped, scooter or motorcycle. Permission will not be knowingly granted to a student to leave campus in a borrowed vehicle.
7. Special care should be exercised to observe all laws and speed limits in driving through the school zone, the parking lots, and the surrounding streets.
8. Proof of insurance is required before authorization can be granted for vehicles used to transport students to or from school. The school student accident insurance does not cover accidents involving unauthorized vehicles.
9. Transportation for field trips or other school activities arranged by the school administration or sponsors will be by van, automobile or bus, **Students will not drive on field trips.**
10. The student is responsible for informing the office when using any other vehicle other than that student's registered vehicle.
11. MVA reserves the right to search any student vehicle if there is suspicion of the possession of illegal drugs or weapons.
